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#### 1. Basis of preparation

The interim financial report is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with Malaysian Financial Reporting Standard ("MFRS") 134 "Interim Financial Reporting" and paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and should be read in conjunction with the Group's audited financial statements for the financial year ended 30 June 2024. This interim financial report also complies with International Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" issued by the International Accounting Standards Board.

The accounting policies and presentation adopted for this interim financial report are consistent with those adopted in the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 30 June 2024 except for the adoption of MFRS accounting standards, interpretations and amendments that are effective for financial year beginning on or after 1 July 2024 which are applicable to the Group. The initial adoption of these applicable MFRSs, amendments and interpretations do not have any material impact on the financial statements of the Group.

#### 2. Qualification of audit report of the preceding annual financial statements

The audit report for the preceding annual financial statements was not qualified.

#### 3. Seasonality or cyclicality of interim operations

The operations of the Group generally follow the performance of the construction industry.

# 4. Nature and amount of items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income, or cash flows that are unusual because of their nature, size, or incidence

There were no items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income, or cash flows that are unusual because of their nature, size, or incidence during the quarter under review and financial year-to-date.

There were no changes in estimates of amounts reported in prior financial years.

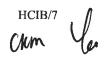
#### 6. Issuances, cancellations, repurchases, resale and repayments of debt and equity securities

There were 2,438,600 additional shares purchased by the Executive Share Scheme ("ESS") Trust during the quarter under review and 3,575,700 during the financial year-to-date.

As at 31 March 2025, the total number of ordinary shares in the Company held by the ESS Trust was 3,882,467 ordinary shares.

During the quarter under review and financial year-to-date, a total of 16,233 ordinary shares of the Company held in the ESS Trust were transferred to an eligible executive of the Group arising from the vesting of free shares pursuant to the ESS.

There were no issuance of shares, share buy-back, shares cancellation, resale of treasury shares or repayments of debt or equity securities during the quarter under review and financial year-to-date.



#### 7. **Dividend paid**

During the financial year-to-date, the Company paid an interim single tier dividend of 4.0 sen per share amounting to RM29.0 million on 18 December 2024.

#### 9. Material events not reflected in the financial statements

There are no material subsequent events to be disclosed as at the date of this report.

### 10. Changes in the composition of the Group

There were no changes in the composition of the Group during the quarter under review, including business combinations, acquisition or disposal of subsidiaries and long-term investments, restructuring and discontinuing operations.



#### 11. Review of performance

For the quarter under review, the Group recorded revenue of RM277.7 million and profit before taxation ("PBT") of RM58.0 million as compared with revenue and PBT of RM310.4 million and RM79.6 million respectively for the corresponding quarter of the preceding financial year ended 30 June 2024 ("FY 2024").

The drop in revenue and PBT as compared to the corresponding quarter of FY 2024 was mainly due to lower cement sales volume as well as one off costs related to the outcome of the strategic review for the concrete business in Peninsular Malaysia.

For the financial year-to-date, the Group recorded revenue of RM851.2 million and PBT of RM220.2 million as compared with revenue and PBT of RM939.3 million and RM222.3 million respectively for the corresponding period of FY 2024. The reduction in revenue and PBT was primarily attributable to the decline in cement sales volume, partially offset by a gain from the disposal of asset held for sale and lower input and production costs.

#### 12. Material changes in profit before taxation ("PBT") against the immediate preceding quarter

The Group recorded PBT of RM58.0 million for the quarter under review as compared with PBT of RM100.4 million for the immediate preceding quarter. The decrease was primarily due to lower sales volume as well as one off costs related to the outcome of the strategic review for the concrete business in Peninsular Malaysia. In addition, the higher PBT in the immediate preceding quarter included a one off gain from the disposal of asset held for sale.

#### 13. Prospects

The construction sector in Malaysia is expected to maintain its momentum. Management remains committed to operational excellence and cost optimisation to maintain efficiency and performance. Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Board maintains a positive outlook and expects the Group's performance for the financial year to be satisfactory.

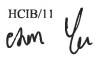

#### 20. Dividend

The basic earnings per ordinary share for the financial year-to-date is calculated by dividing the Group's profit attributable to owners of the Company of RM169,565,000 (3<sup>rd</sup> quarter FY2024: RM168,453,000) by the weighted average number of ordinary shares during the period of 721,602,000 (3<sup>rd</sup> quarter FY 2024: 562,603,000).

#### 22. Derivatives

The Group uses forward foreign exchange contracts to manage its exposure to various financial risks.

#### Forward foreign exchange contracts

The Group has entered into a number of forward foreign exchange contracts by a subsidiary to hedge the cash flow risk in relation to the variations of cash flows arising from future forecasted transactions.

The forward foreign exchange contracts are stated at fair value using observable market prices in active markets, including recent market transactions and valuation techniques that include discounted cash flow models and option pricing models, as appropriate.

As at 31 March 2025, the contract amount, fair value and maturity tenor of the forward foreign exchange contracts were as follows:

Derivatives (which are classified as financial assets/liabilities) categorised as fair value through profit or loss are subsequently measured at their fair values with the gains/(losses) recognised in profit or loss.

There is no change to the type of derivative financial contracts entered into, cash requirements of the derivatives, risk associated with the derivatives and the risk management objectives and policies to mitigate these risks since the previous financial year ended 30 June 2024.

### 23. Gains/losses arising from fair value changes of financial liabilities

Other than derivatives which are classified as financial liabilities, when they are at fair value loss position, the Group does not re-measure its financial liabilities at fair value after the initial recognition.
